He traveled around Palm Beach County and eventually made his way back to West Palm Beach and met The Lord's Place Engagement Team. Because of his vulnerability, the team worked quickly to help with his finances and find him housing. Despite having issues with housing in the past, The Lord's Place has found a home for him in one of the Operation Home Ready single apartments.

Today, Eddy lives in his own apartment, his medications are balanced, and he is happy to be sleeping in a bed, cleaning his apartment, and being around other people.
