



The Lord's Place's Family Campus was created in 1983 as a temporary shelter, but it has since evolved into an essential community resource that has assisted countless families out of homelessness. Last year, The Lord's Place's Family Campus, located in **West Palm Beach**, housed 50 families who would have otherwise been homeless. The 37-apartment complex is recognized for serving those with the greatest barriers to stability. Families who often struggle with mental illness, substance use, disability, intergenerational poverty, long-term unemployment, lack of education, and criminal justice involvement.

It offers two distinct but complementary programs, a **permanent supportive housing** program for chronically homeless families with disabilities, and a **transitional housing** program for those who would otherwise fall through the cracks of our homeless system because they are not eligible for other housing programs. It is a **critical resource** for these children and parents, providing housing, case management and comprehensive supportive services at its .
