



The Lord's Place Men's Campus, located in Boynton Beach and home to 50 men, is comprised of two supportive housing programs: Joshua House is the permanent supportive housing program and the Recovery Center is the transitional housing program. Together, the programs offer a seamless continuum of housing services for homeless men.

Joshua House serves residents who have demonstrated a commitment to personal growth and success and are considered leaders at the Men's Campus. The Recovery Center serves those who have struggled with substance abuse and/or

chronic homelessness, as well as ex-offenders who have become homeless after being released from incarceration.

For more than two decades, the Men's Campus has focused on being client-centered. When faced with the difficult decision to keep federal funding that did not align with our client's sober living paradigm - our agency made a deliberate decision to uphold the values of the program despite the risk to its financial sustainability. Thanks to private funding, the Men's Campus continues to offer a safe environment for men in recovery.
