One day in mid September, a man in his 60s was found wandering the streets in West Palm Beach by the police. He was lucid, but visibly sick and very dirty with no way to care for himself. The Lord's Place outreach specialist was called to meet him, and brought a therapist from a local agency for consultation.

His name was Don, and he was willing to listen because he had heard of The Lord's Place before and was familiar with the sort of care and assistance offered. The peer specialist and therapist took time to talk to Don, realizing he had been in and out of hospitals and likely on the streets for years. They were able to get him to another agency to get cleaned up before taking him to the hospital for medical treatment. Since then, our team is in the process of helping him obtain long term care with a nursing facility though St. Mary's Medical Center. Don will finally get the care he needs, with a roof over his head. We are so pleased to be Opening the Doors for Don and other people in our community.

## Program Spotlight



Rafael was referred to the SOAR program by his caseworker at the Men's Campus. Rafael suffered from a disease that caused swelling of his joints and required them to be treated often. SOAR staff worked with Rafael and was able to get him approved for disability benefits. Thanks to his SSI benefits, Rafael was able to transition out of the Men's Campus and secured housing on his own. Rafael continues to do well and is living independently with the financial support of his disability benefits.

The Lord's Place offers a unique service to our clients with severe and persistent disabilities that have lasted at least 12 months. Our SSI/SSDI Outreach, Access, and Recovery program, known as **SOAR**, assists people who are experiencing, or are at imminent risk of experiencing, homelessness. This program helps clients navigate challenging systems to access their Supplemental Security Income and Social Security Disability Insurance, and begin their journey out of homelessness and into improved health and well-being. This past year, 84% of applications with a final decision were approved! Rafael was one of our success stories.
