<b>Street Outreach and Engagement:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Promoted Joey Nieves to Supervisor of Street Engagement and Jennifer Sellars to Director of Street Outreach and Engagement.</li> <li>Contract renewed with the City of West Palm Beach that includes new partnership with Mental Health Association (MHA) to provide connection to mental health during street outreach.</li> </ul>
<b>Housing:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Purchased land to build Burckle Place III and developed unique housing concept for communal and individual spaces.</li> <li>Coordinating with Carrfour to consider providing supportive services for Alice Moore housing project that was formerly contracted with Jerome Golden.</li> </ul>
<b>Job Training and Employment:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Launched Clean Team expansion with 2 additional, part-time positions in partnership with DDA.</li> <li>Awarded \$29.5K from Impact of Palm Beaches for Digital Readiness Class.</li> </ul>
<b>Re-Entry:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continued planning for the SCA grant implementation beginning October 2020.</li> <li>Established location for Re-Entry Summit in October of 2020.</li> <li>Advocated for TLP Re-Entry Appropriations Bill; received invitation to meet and request for additional information from the Governor's office.</li> <li>Challenge: Project Turnaround has experienced challenges in the implementation of this pilot due to major changes in the main referral source, St. Mary's Hospital. Establishing alternative referral sources with the Mayor's office.</li> </ul>
<b>Ancillary Services:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Women's Services: FSU's College of Social Work and Institute of Justice Research and Development applied for a grant focusing on medical and substance use interventions for women and children.</li> <li>Children's Services: Began extra-curricular partnership with Center for Creative Education (CCE) where youth participate in technology, science, and art activities.</li> <li>SOAR: Continue coordination to address SOAR needs in community.</li> <li>CARE Coordination: Began partnership with Genesis Community Health, Inc. to provide medical assistance to high-risk clients.</li> </ul>
