What Is A Beneficiary?

A beneficiary a legal term to denote a person who enjoys, or has the prospect of enjoying, any interest or estate held in trust by others.

- Most beneficiary designation forms are very flexible. You can name The Lord's Place as a "full" beneficiary or "partial" beneficiary. You can also name The Lord's Place as a "primary" or "contingent" beneficiary along with your family.

Next Steps When Considering a Beneficiary Designation Gift

1. To make your gift, contact your account administrator or the person who helps you with your account or insurance policy, such as your broker, banker or insurance agent.
2. Ask them to send you a new beneficiary designation form.
3. Complete the form, sign it and send it back to your broker, banker or agent.
4. When you pass away, your account or insurance policy will be paid or transferred to The Lord's Place, consistent with the beneficiary designation.
