- Flashlights
- Batteries
- Dried Milk
- Can Openers
- Powdered drink
- Antibacterial wipes
- Bleach
- Battery operated personal fans

- Disposable raincoats
- Umbrellas
- Battery packs to charge devices
- Hygiene packs (toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, wash cloth, lotion)
- Canned and nonperishable food, especially proteins and cans with pop-tops.
- Bottled water
- Individually packaged protein bars and snacks
