

Current Volunteer Opportunities:

Fortin Family Campus – The Lord's Place Headquarters at 2808 N Australian Avenue:

- **Café Joshua** - Serves hot meals every weekday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. to our currently homeless clients. We are in need of volunteers to greet clients, take orders, and serve food, as the Café is restaurant style. We also are in need of volunteers to serve as table companions, which involves sitting and talking with clients who may be eating alone, to provide companionship and support.
- **Job Training** - Resume writing, interview skills, teaching classes on basic literacy, reading and writing, basic math, computer competency, mediation, conflict resolution, and anything else which will help our clients to gain and maintain employment.
- **Activities** - Bring an activity or class to our engagement center for our clients to learn and enjoy. We can be creative, from bringing an instrument to play to providing an art demonstration.
- **Administrative Work** - Filing, mailing, secretarial duties, data entry, etc.
- **Deliveries** - Sorting, picking up, and transporting donations to various locations around Palm Beach County.

Special Events:

We are seeking volunteers to organize events for holidays and special times, including decorating and planning, as well as individual volunteers or groups to sponsor outings for our clients. These would involve taking small groups of clients to dinner, a movie, a museum, or anywhere that would broaden their horizons or simply be fun! We also have fundraising events that we seek help with throughout the year.

Housing Campuses:

- **Seminars/Workshops** - Financial literacy, cooking, sewing, organizational skills, maintaining a household, computer skills, self-esteem, trauma counseling, and other miscellaneous life skills.
- **Body Care** - Haircuts & manicures.
- **Administrative Work** - Filing, mailing, secretarial duties, data entry, etc.

Reentry:

- **COSA** – Standing for “Circles of Support and Accountability,” this program entails a group of 3-4 volunteers providing support and companionship for a set 1-hour meeting once per week to a client who is coming out of incarceration. These meetings will be scheduled around the availability of the volunteers and clients.
